Chinese Whispers: Bay Chronicles[™] retraces the history of Chinese shrimp fishing in San Francisco Bay, through sailings on the *Grace Quan*, a 43-foot replica of a 19th century Chinese shrimp junk, to former Chinese shrimp fishing sites around the Bay.

An interdisciplinary team of visual, sound, and media artists led by Chinese WhispersSM Director Rene Yung will chronicle the sails along with a historical ecologist from the San Franciso Estuary Institute, and NPS' John C. Muir, who led the building of the Park's *Grace Quan*, as skipper. The project will culminate in a transmedia art installation at the SF Maritime NHP in 2015.

Join us for three unique public programs in Richmond, Hunters Point/SF, and China Camp State Park, that connect each site to the larger history of Chinese shrimp fishing in the Bay. Each will be a distinct, unforgettable experience!
